Rainbow Snake Bubbles



What to do...

- 1. Cut the bottom off of the plastic bottle.
- 2. Slip an old sock over the cut end of the bottle and secure with a rubber band.
- 3. Pour about 4 tbsp of dishwashing liquid onto a plate. Mix in a little water to thin the soap.
- 4. To make a rainbow, squirt food coloring on sock.
- 5. Dip the sock end of the bottle into the dishwashing solution.
- 6. Blow through the mouth of the bottle to make a rainbow snake bubbles.
- 7. Do not inhale or suck air in. You will inhale bubbles. Only blow out air.
- 8. This is a messy project and should be done outside. The food coloring will stain your fingers and clothing. You can rinse your bubble wand and let it air dry if you wish to use it again.

How are bubbles formed? Bubbles are pockets of soap and water that are filled with air. When soap and water are mixed together and air is blown into the mixture, the soap forms a thin skin and traps the air, creating a bubble.
